In most great cities there is a building that epitomises its spirit and history. In Melbourne, it is undoubtedly the Royal Exhibition Building. It stands proudly within the beauty of Carlton Gardens. Together they form Australia's first built World Heritage Site.

Location

Situated on the city fringe, nestled between Nicholson Street and Rathdown Street in the picturesque Carlton Gardens.

The Royal Exhibition Building is ideal for large scale gala dinners, car launches, prestigious major events such as fashion shows, public or trade exhibitions.

Adjoining Melbourne's CBD, this World Heritage-listed venue has a renowned history of serving Australia's international exhibition and event industry for over 125 years.

The building features premium interior floor space of 11,500 square metres over two levels, 5000 square metres of versatile outdoor precincts, excellent public transport access and undercover parking.
